







- Eight weeks per semester






## CW Academy

- 4 to 5 students per class




# What is the teaching method of CW Academy?





#### **Teaching Method**

- Beginner Level is always sent at 20 words per minute
- Course emphasizes sending as well as receiving characters at 20 WPM (we start with Farnsworth of 2 to 3 WPM).
- Farnsworth speed (spacing between characters) is increased as the class progresses
- Most popular letters are taught first, with letters being introduced in the order of their use in English language



## What is needed to participate in CW Academy?

- A "paddle" (lambic or single lever paddle)
- A keyer or a transceiver with an internal keyer
- Computer
- Video camera, microphone






## The Four Levels...






#### Developed with beginners in mind...

- No previous code experience/proficiency
- If you learned CW a while back but are really rusty
- If your code speed is under 10 to 12 WPM




- Students are provided with a handbook (lesson guide)
- We use a program which is customized for CW Academy called Morse Code Trainer
- After session 10 on air activity is emphasized



What is expected to succeed?


Attend online sessions (2 each week)

Practice 45 minutes <u>each</u> day




#### What is the end goal of Beginner level?

- Learn Morse Code characters (letters, numbers, and some punctuation)
- Learn to head copy and send Morse Code
- Learn on-air protocols of a basic QSO
- Use skills for on-air basic QSOs



### Basic Level

- If you know Morse Code, but your speed is <10 WPM</li>
- Increase head copy and send skills using Instant Character Recognition
- Increase skills for on-air conversational QSOs
- Introduction to contesting skills



## Intermediate Level

- If your code speed is 10+WPM
- You have Instant Character Recognition Skills






## Intermediate Level

#### **Class Objectives:**

- Increase copy and send skills by use of contesting tools
- Increase head copy skills
- Recognize words as sounds
- Increase on-air experience with various types of QSOs



## Advanced Level

- Advanced is for folks who can head-copy 15+ WPM
- Class focus On-air operating at speed of 25 + WPM
- Daily practice of 1 hour. Many on-air sessions with instructor and classmates



## Advanced Level


#### **Class Objectives:**

- Increase head copy and send skills for higher-speed on-air activity
- Increase on-air experience with various types of higherspeed QSOs
- Increase contesting skills to 30+ wpm
- Recognize phrases as sounds
- Learn to copy from behind
- Increase overall skills to be considered for CWops membership

## Advanced Level

- Course lasts 8 weeks, two sessions each week
- Daily practice of 1 hour





## Youth Program


- Beginner Level
- Designed for youth between 9 and 19 years old
- "Fast Tracks" waiting list
- Intended to help youth get a license and/or get on CW
- Special deal with MFJ for portable antenna


