Background


- First licensed 1976 as (Novice) WB0UGM in High School

Volunteers on the Air (VOTA)

- Year-Long Operating Event to Celebrate ARRL's Volunteers
 - Started Jan 1, 2023; Ends Dec 31, 2023
- Similar to 2014 ARRL Centennial Celebration and 2018 Int'l Grid Chase; driven wholly by QSOs uploaded to LoTW
- How to earn points:
 - Contact ARRL Volunteers (Officers, Division and Section Staff, and Members)
 - Contact W1AW/# Stations in All 50 states

ARRL Club Commission Program

- Your Club earns commission when members **join** or **renew** their ARRL membership
 - NEW Club earns \$15; RENEWAL Club earns \$5; NO LIMIT
- ARRL Member Completes a <u>Membership Application for Affiliated</u>
 <u>Clubs</u>, including full payment **directly to ARRL** (check, credit card, cash)
- Club (Treasurer?) Collects Applications, Submits to ARRL with a Completed <u>Club Commission Reconciliation Form</u>
- ARRL Processes Applications; Club Receives Funds (usually 2-3 weeks)
